NEW SURGERY CENTER. Atlanta-based **Woolfson Eye Institute (WEI)** has opened a roughly \$800,000 ambulatory Surgery Center in the Perimeter area.

The 2,000-square-foot center, which employs about 10, offers cataract surgery, LASIK and cosmetic procedures.

The expansion was needed to meet growing demand, the company said in a statement.

Stulting was medical director of Emory Vision, Emory University's refractive surgery center.

Stulting was also Hughes Professor of Ophthalmology at Emory University.

Stulting participated in the first physician-sponsored clinical investigation of LASIK, prior to refractive laser's FDA approval in the United States, according to the statement.
